Scope and Topics of Interest: We welcome original research, review articles, and clinical perspectives on topics including (but not limited to):

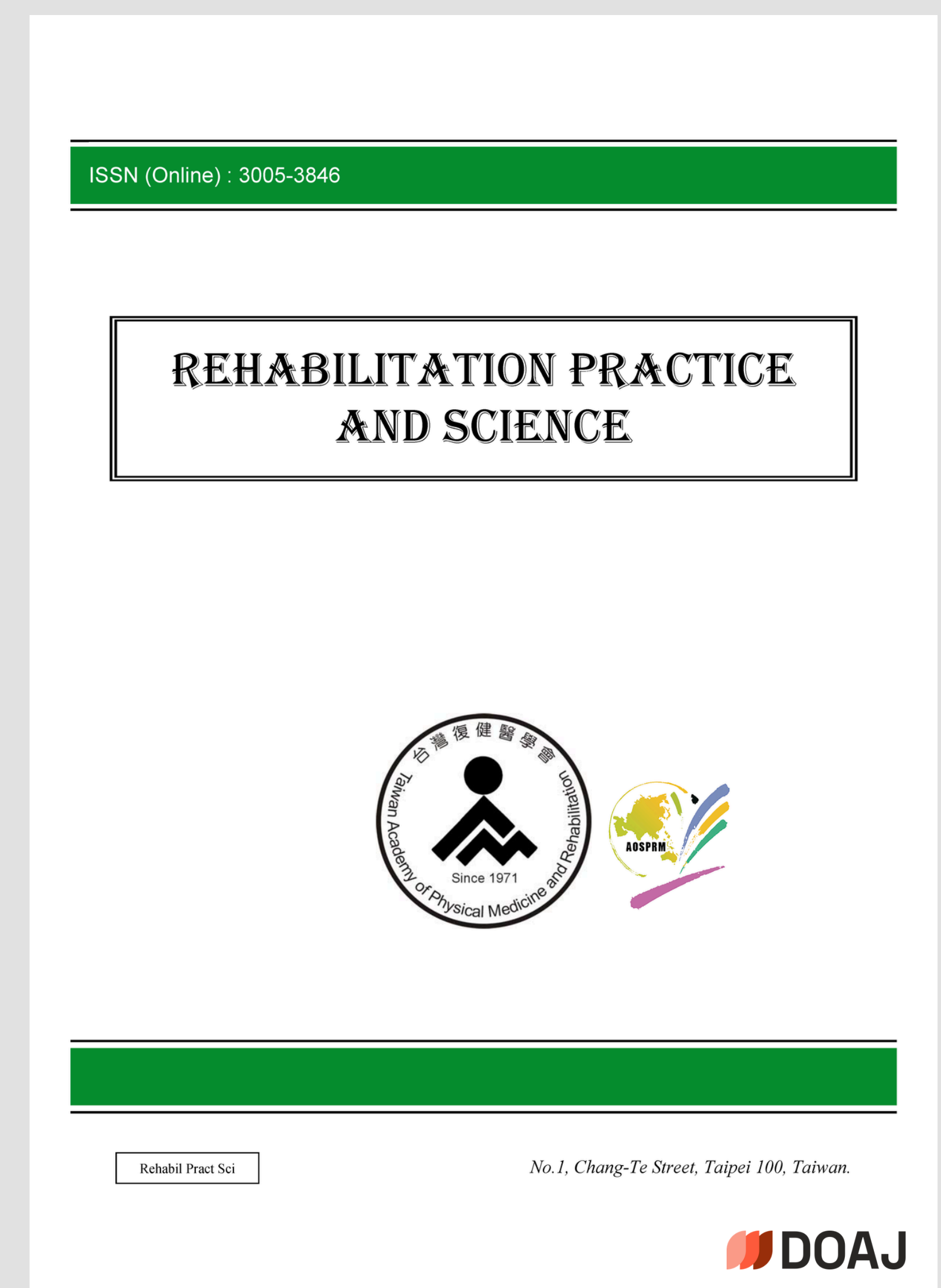
- Exercise training and physical activity interventions
